



# Conference Scholarship Program

**\*\*\* Your Club can earn a chance to win a scholarship to the Spring 2010 District 38 Conference! \*\*\***

There are several ways to qualify:

- “Distinguished” by December - Earn 5 or more DCP points and have a membership level of 20+ members or base +5 by 12/31/09 (Official Distinguished status is not determined until after April dues renewals.)
- Earn 5 or more CCs by March 31, 2010
- Earn 3 or more ACs by March 31, 2010
- Earn 3 or more Leadership Awards by March 31, 2010
- Renew Club dues with Base +5 or more by March 31, 2010

**In addition to the already exciting events to be held during this Conference – such as the International Speech Contest, the C & L Award Luncheon and the John E. Foster Award / Installation Dinner – District 38 will be hosting International 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President, Michael Notaro, DTM. An international officer only visits a District once in every 7 years, so this will be an event not to miss!!!**

In conjunction with the Say CC! and Advanced Leader incentive programs for members, District 38 is offering the Conference Scholarship Program for Clubs. Each of the incentives in this program is designed to stretch the achievements of each club to go beyond the standard goals set for us every year. Some clubs exceed these goals yearly, but that is only a small portion of our total clubs.

**In 2008-2009:**

- 12 clubs had earned 5 or more DCP points by December 31, 2008.
- 0 clubs had earned 5 CCs by March 31 although 3 clubs earned all 4 CCs by this time.
- 2 clubs had earned 3 ACs by March 31
- 3 clubs earned 3 or more Leadership Awards by March 31
- 15 clubs renewed with Base +5 or more by March 31

\*\*\* This incentive provides one scholarship valued at \$100 to the Spring 2010 District 38 Conference to be held April 30 – May 1, 2010. The value of this incentive is not transferable for any other use and may not cover the full registration cost of the conference. The club earning the incentive determines to which club member the incentive is assigned. Suggestions include: drawing among new members; drawing among members who earned awards that qualified for the incentive; drawing among members who have never attended a District Conference. \*\*\*

**NOTE:** Winners of the conference scholarships will be determined by a drawing from the names of all clubs who qualify. Qualifying in multiple categories provides multiple chances to win although only one scholarship will be awarded per club.

The drawing will occur after March 31, 2010. A minimum of 10 scholarships will be awarded unless fewer than 10 clubs qualify. In that case, only that number of scholarships will be awarded. More than 10 scholarships may be awarded if the budget allows. This will be determined at the end of the incentive period.

Clubs do not have to register for this incentive program. It will be monitored by the District 38 Awards Coordinator.
